



## **Participation of the 2 EK Peirea in the Erasmus + KA2 project EntreVET**

The transition from school to professional life is one of the most difficult moments in life.

Career development is a process, not just a destination. Unfortunately, the education system does not pay enough attention to the developmental process required for the future employee to engage in a careful, thorough career development.

This need is met by the two-year strategic partnership Erasmus + KA2 entitled 'EntreVET' (Code 2018-1-DE02-KA202-005130) in which 2 EK Peirea participated as a partner.

The purpose of the program is to develop the entrepreneurial skills of TEE students, but also to strengthen their professional orientation.

The objectives of the project are:

- Mapping and evaluating the role of career guidance in supporting entrepreneurship learning in initial vocational education and training.
- The design and offering of a complete professional development program for teachers and career counselors, in order to upgrade the services provided to TEE students for a better career orientation towards their future business paths.
- The creation of CAREER HUBS based on the creation of synergies between the labor market, the media, TEE schools, etc. in order to support the learning opportunities offered to students, as well as opportunities in their real professional life.

As part of this program, training materials were developed, a complete toolbox for educators as well as a free access platform, which contains the business skills development program.

For the implementation and coordination of the program, 3 live meetings were held, while the last meeting was held online due to the pandemic. We also conducted a pilot training which was performed also online. The teachers and students trainings were also carried out online. At the end of the program we held a multiplier event at our school with participants from schools from Piraeus and Attica, as well as counselors and entrepreneurs.
